They must have attended a minimum of one FHMT meeting (held monthly throughout the school year) and must have worked at least twice during the current school year at FHMT Fund-raisers or club-sponsored events.** PLEASE NOTE: For the 2020-21 school year, the family requirement for attending meetings and volunteering has been waived due to the pandemic but the family should have been a dues paying member for the 2019-2020 school year.

Requirements:

- 1. Typed Essay: How have you contributed to the success of the chorus program and what has this experience meant to you?
- 2. A copy of the letter of acceptance from the college, university, or accredited institution of higher education you will be attending.
